ADDICTION SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (ASH)

This program provides addiction case management services coupled with a housing supplement to assist persons with problematic substance use to find and maintain adequate housing. This program is delivered across the South Eastern Ontario Region.

For individuals with problematic substance use who:

- are currently involved in or have completed an addictions treatment plan
- have a history of multiple entries to various addiction treatment services
- are homeless, at risk of being homeless or inadequate housing
- have a high probability of being successful in a supportive housing program
- are willing to identify harm reduction or abstinence substance use goal(s) & constructively participate in the ASH program

Services include:

- community-based services offered in the client's environment of choice
- Individualized assessment & treatment planning
- addictions counselling & support
- life skills development
- service navigation & coordination
- system advocacy
- personal advocacy
- relapse prevention & crisis planning
