The Board of Directors of Canadian Mental Health Association Hastings Prince Edward (CMHA HPE) is currently recruiting individuals 18 years or older who have a permanent residence or work in the counties of Hastings or Prince Edward. The Board of Directors is seeking to fill vacancies based on areas of expertise identified by the Board as essential to its work on behalf of the organization. We are seeking individuals with one of the following: a **strong financial**, **legal**, **human resources or fundraising and community development background** as well as individuals with **strong quality improvement orientation**. A working knowledge of health systems is an asset.

We encourage applications from members of groups that have been historically disadvantaged and marginalized, including but not limited to Aboriginal, Indigenous, Metis and Inuit peoples, racialized groups/persons of colour, people with varying abilities, members of visible minority groups, LGBTQ2S+, those who identify as women, and other equity-seeking groups.

We are committed to inclusive, barrier-free recruitment, selection processes, and work environments. When contacted for a volunteer opportunity, please advise the Human Resources department of any accommodations needed in accordance with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 and the Ontario Human Rights Code to ensure you have access to a fair and equitable process. We request that you provide your accommodation request as soon as reasonably practicable. Any information received relating to accommodation will be addressed confidentially.

CMHA HPE is a not-for-profit organization serving citizens in the Counties of Hastings and Prince Edward. The Head Office is located in Belleville, ON with satellite offices throughout the two Counties. CMHA HPE is a dynamic and growing organization, serving the addictions and/or mental health needs of more than 5,000 individuals per year in a variety of clinical programs and services.

The work of the Board of Directors is conducted using a committee structure. The Board meets regularly, on a monthly basis, 10 months of the year. Board members are expected to sit on one Committee of the Board. A minimum commitment of 4-5 hours per month is required. A term is 3 years with a possibility of renewal.
