The Registered Nurse (RN) at our Rapid Access Addiction Medicine (RAAM) Clinic will support the provision of low-barrier addictions medicine care to individuals with substance use disorders in a variety of settings, including in office and in the communities of Hastings and Prince Edward Counties.

The RN has a passion for Addictions Medicine, a thorough understanding of Concurrent Disorders, and a recovery-based, trauma informed approach to care. - Demonstrated knowledge of the Mental Health Act, the Health Care Consent Act and other relevant legislation
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Be open and non-judgmental
- Possess knowledge and proficiency in current, evidenced-based methods and practices of primary care delivery, with an emphasis on health promotion and risk reduction
- Demonstrate superior leadership, organization, evaluation, time management, communication and interpersonal skills
- Be proficient in the use of the computer hardware and software, including PS Suites/other MARs, Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook
- Prior experience and knowledge of electronic medical record management
- Experience working as part of an interdisciplinary team
- Evidence of professional practice liability insurance (minimum \$5M, per professional practice requirements)
- Required to provide a satisfactory criminal reference check (CRC) with vulnerable sector screen prior to hire
- Must possess a valid Ontario Driver's License, have regular access to a reliable vehicle and provide proof of adequate vehicle insurance, as necessary for the position
